SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER AND PANEL PROPOSALS

1. Please do not submit an application for both a preconstituted panel and to the open call. Individuals may appear in only one capacity at the conference.
2. For individual papers, please submit an abstract (250 words), a CV (2 pages maximum), and a brief bibliography
3. For preconstituted panel submissions, submit the following together in one Word document:
 - A proposal abstract for the panel (250 words)
 - A abstract for each individual panelist's paper (250 words)
 - A CV and short bibliography for each panelist
 - Name and contact information for a faculty member who might be willing to serve as panel moderator (optional)
4. If your panel and/or paper presentation will require any visual media, *please plan your panel and presentation based on the available equipment:*
 - VHS player
 - DVD player
 - Computer (for displaying web images)

Please indicate on your proposal if individual panelists will provide their own laptop computers

Please note: Equipment will only be provided for presentations that include visual media. We are unable to provide equipment, such as computers, LCD projectors, screens, or transparency projectors, for text-only presentations. You are invited to bring copies of PowerPoint presentations or other materials as handouts.

5. Organizers of panels are responsible for submitting the entire panel proposal by the deadline of November 3, 2006.
